An incomplete blockade of the sinoatrial node was diagnosed on the ECG. After the appointment of cardiotonics, bradycardia began to increase, hypotension developed. Please name the complication that has occurred over the next 5 minutes. What gland dysfunction has developed, what laboratory parameters need to be clarified to make a complete clinical diagnosis, what symptoms will arise in the future? Which group of drugs should be used, indicate the main links in the pathogenesis of the complication.
