

Station: “Internal diseases. Written”

Sick 25 years old, went to the family outpatient clinic on day 6 of the disease with complaints of headache, chills, pain in the left hypochondrium. The onset of the disease is acute: a fever has appeared, the temperature has risen to 39.9°C. After 8 hours the temperature dropped to 37.2°C. The next day the chill recurred, the temperature rose again to 40°C. Epidemiological history: patient arrived from Congo 11 days ago. Objectively: the skin is pale. No rash. Tongue moist, covered with white plaque. Peripheral lymph nodes are not palpable. Rhythmic heartbeat, 100 beats per minute. Heart tones are muted. In the lungs - no features. The abdomen is soft, a little painful on palpation in the left hypochondrium. The liver protrudes from the edge of the costal arch 2 cm, moderate density, sensitive to palpation. The spleen protrudes from the edge of the costal arch 1 cm. Meningeal signs are absent.
