

**Student action algorithm for the discipline “Internal medicine”
Station “Standardized patient”**

1. Say hello to the patient
2. Introduce yourself
3. Explain to the patient what you will do
4. Ask for permission from the patient for examination
5. Specify passport data:
 - a. Identify patient (ask for name)
 - b. Ask about the patient's age
6. Find out complaints:
 - c. Find out the main complaints
 - d. Clarify each additional feature of the complaint with a separate question.
 - e. Clarify additional complaints - each with a separate question.
7. Question the medical history:
 - f. Duration - when the first attacks occurred
 - g. Were there complications in the past medical history (each with a separate question).
8. Ask for life history and identify risk factors, each with a separate question
9. Specify other diseases that increase the risk of underlying disease.
10. Establish a preliminary diagnosis
11. Make recommendations on the correction of risk factors or on further diagnostic / treatment tactics, depending on the question posed.
