Situational task № 1

The child of 11 years complains of sharp, spontaneous, paroxysmal pain in a tooth on the upper jaw on the right. Cold water causes a prolonged attack of pain. Objectively: on the distal-contact surface 26 a carious cavity filled with light softened dentin, localized within the peripulpar dentin, was detected. Probing the bottom of the carious cavity is sharply painful, percussion of the tooth is painless. The child has a history of allergy to anesthetics. Acute diffuse pulpitis of 26 teeth was diagnosed.
