The student's action algorithm for practical skill: "Anterior nasal tamponade"

- 1. Make a decision about the method of epistaxis stopping and say it out loud: "To stopping of the bleeding in your case I must make the anterior nasal tamponade".
- 2. Inform the patient about the procedure (if he is conscious). The information should include information about the aim and technique of this procedure: "After appropriate preparation I will insert tampon into the nasal passage. It will compress the vessels and stop the bleeding. Then I will examine the pharynx to prevent blood flowing along its posterior wall."
- 3. Wear rubber gloves
- 4. Give the patient a seated position or horizontal position with a raised head end.
- 5. Give him a plastic blood collection tray.
- 6. Soak the tampon with a Vaseline oil or antibiotic ointment.
- 7. Take the end of the tampon with tweezers stepping back 4 cm.
- 8. Using bayonet-shaped tweezers insert tampon into the dummy of the nasal cavity to the posterior region until it stops.
 - 9. The rest loops of the tampon are laid vertically from top to bottom.
- 10. Using a spatula make pharyngoscopy to exclude blood flowing along the posterior pharyngeal wall.
 - 11. Put a sling on the nose.
 - 12. Inform the patient about the end of the procedure.
 - 13. Remove rubber gloves.
