Standardized patient. Interviewing a patient with chest pain.

Student action algorithm:

- 1. Say hello to the patient
- 2. Introduce yourself
- 3. Explain to the patient what you will do
- 4. Ask for permission from the patient for examination
- 5. Specify passport data:
 - Identify patient (ex.: ask his name)
 - Ask about the patient's age
- 6. Find out complaints:
 - Find out the main complaints
 - Clarify the type of the pain
 - Specify provocation by emotional stress or exertion
 - Specify whether pain is relieved by nitrate or rest
 - Specify localization
 - Specify the intensity
 - Specify the duration
 - Clarify the irradiation of pain
- 7. Question the medical history:
 - Duration when the first attacks occurred
 - Have a history of a heart attack / stroke
- 8. Question the life history and identify risk factors:
 - Smoking
 - Heredity
 - Sedentary lifestyle

Other diseases that increase cardio-vascular risks

- Hypertension
- Type 2 CD
- CKD
- 9. Establish a preliminary diagnosis
- 10. Make recommendations on risk factor correction.
