Scenario "Focal survey of a therapeutic patient with chest pain"

You work as a family doctor. Ivan Ivanov, 65 years old, turned to you about chest pain. BP = 135/85 mm Hg, PS = 80 bpm. Conduct a focal survey of the patient for 5 minutes, establish a preliminary diagnosis and provide recommendations for the correction of risk factors.

Task:

- 1. Say hello to the patient, introduce yourself, explain what you are going to do.
- 2. Identify the patient (for example, ask what his name is, or say hello to him by First Name).
- 3. Find out the patient's complaints, detail them.
- 4. Collect a history of the disease, specifying all the features of its course.
- 5. Find out the life history, paying particular attention to the risk factors for the underlying disease.
- 6. Establish a preliminary clinical diagnosis.
- 7. Give advices on the correction of identified risk factors.
