

**Station: "Standardized patient.
Communication skills. Collection of anamnesis »**

Patient, Potapova Iryna Ivanivna, 23, addressed you, a doctor at the Center for Primary Health Care, with the complaints to sudden attacks of dizziness, tachycardia, lack of oxygen, and fear of death. She considers herself ill for 3 months. She lives in a dormitory, eats irregularly. She admits to the medical help for the first time.

Objective: blood pressure: = 130/100 mm Hg, PS = 104 beats / min. Facial redness. Hyperhidrosis of the palms.

Task: Conduct a focus survey of the patient for 5 minutes, make a preliminary diagnosis and provide recommendations for the correction of risk factors.

1. Clarify the patient's complaints, detail them.
2. Collect a history of the disease, clarifying all the features of its course.
3. Find out your life history, paying special attention to the risk factors for the underlying disease.
4. Establish a preliminary clinical diagnosis.
5. Give recommendations for the correction of identified risk factors.
