

Station «Internal medicine»: skills and manipulations
Scenario № 1

For the student

You are the doctor of the reception ward at the multi-profile hospital. You are addressed by patient L., age 58 years. He reports intensive pressing pain behind the sternum, irradiating to the left hand and shoulder. Symptoms duration 6 hours; nitroglycerin treatment would not help.

Diagnosis “angina pectoris” has been established 2 years ago.

History: smoking, blood pressure elevated for 15 years. No regular treatment. No blood pressure control.

Tasks:

1. Register an ECG (on manikin).
2. Give an assessment of an ECG (see the appendix).
3. Establish a diagnosis of the underlying disease.
4. Make a plan of laboratory tests for the diagnosis of myocardial infarction.
5. Identify the group of drugs for the treatment of the underlying disease.
