Algorithm.

"Examination of a venereal patient with ulcer on the genitals"

- 1. Say hello to the patient.
- 2. Introduce yourself.
- 3. Identify the patient (name, age).
- 4. Clarify and detail complaints:
 - find out complaints (rashes on the genitals, swollen lymph nodes)
 - clarify the location of each complaint
 - find out the subjective sensations in the area of complaints: itching, burning, pain.
 - find out the general condition of the patient: weakness, lethargy, malaise, headache, fever
- 5. To ask the medical history:
 - duration of the disease
 - when the first symptoms of the disease appeared
 - what were the first symptoms of the disease
 - the development of the disease
 - the order of occurrence of complaints, their development
 - the possible cause of the onset of the disease, in the patient's opinion
 - what preceded the first symptoms of the disease
 - previous treatment (self-medication) and its results
- 6. Describe the clinical picture from photographic illustration (if required by the task):
 - prevalence of skin lesions:
- localization of rashes (area, side of the body)
- describe the focus of the rash: primary (secondary) morphological lesions, shape, size, color, edges, appearance, bottom, signs of inflammation.
 - lymph nodes: localization of enlarged lymph nodes (area, on one side or symmetrically), the condition of the skin above them
- 7. Establish a preliminary diagnosis (if required by the task)
- 8. Assign examination methods to confirm or deny the preliminary diagnosis (if required by the task)

- 9. Based on the results of the examination, make a final diagnosis. (if the task requires it)
- 10. Determine the tactics of further management of the patient. (if the task requires it)
