

## INFORMATION ON ADMISSION TO ONMEDU

### ADMISSION IN PERSON

- Register in the Unified Interagency Information System of Ukraine for Foreigners and Stateless Persons (hereinafter referred to as the Unified System).

- Receive an educational offer and invitation through the Unified System
- Obtain a visa for study
- Arrive in Ukraine
- Submit the originals of your documents to the ONMedU
- Pass the entrance exams

### REMOTE ADMISSION

- Register in the Unified Interagency Information System of Ukraine for Foreigners and Stateless Persons (hereinafter referred to as the Unified System).

- Receive an educational offer and invitation through the Unified System
- Pass entrance exams
- In the case of remote admission, a foreigner sends legalized or notarized copies of documents on previous education to ONMedU by post. When crossing the state border of Ukraine for the first time and upon arrival at ONMedU, the foreigner hands over the original documents in person.

The Admission Committee works from **01.07.2025 to 31.10.2025**. For obtaining a master's degree, admission is based on the results of consideration of documents submitted to the admission committee and entrance exams in biology, chemistry and language of study. Entrance examination programs are published on the official website of the University. For the specialty of management, admission is based on the results of consideration of documents submitted to the admission committee and entrance examinations in English, management and administration.

To the application, a copy of the passport and consent to the processing of personal data upon admission in full-time format or in remote format after crossing the state border of Ukraine and upon arrival at ONMedU, the foreigner adds :

- 1) a Document (original and its copy) on the previously obtained educational (educational and qualification) level, on the basis of which admission is made;

4) the original and a copy of the document containing information on the content of the curriculum for the previous degree (level) of higher education, credits received, duration of study and academic performance in academic disciplines (in the absence of this information in the Supplement to the document on education) when applying for a master's degree, if the absence of this information makes it impossible to recognize the qualification according to the document;

6) a certificate of prior language training in the case of admission to studies in the Ukrainian language;

8) 4 photographs measuring  $30 \times 40$  mm;

9) a copy of the certificate of a foreign Ukrainian (if available)..

The documents specified in subparagraphs 1 – 5 must be translated into Ukrainian with a notarized translation. The documents specified in subparagraphs 1 – 4 must be certified in the country of their issuance in the manner officially used in this country for such certification, and legalized by the relevant foreign institution of Ukraine, unless otherwise provided for by international treaties of Ukraine

Payment for educational services provided by ONMedU to foreigners is made under an individual agreement that each foreigner concludes with the university personally.

Documents on education of enrolled foreigners issued by educational institutions of other countries are recognized in Ukraine in accordance with the law. The procedure for recognizing documents on previous education must be completed within 1 year after enrollment in accordance with the current legislation of Ukraine.

Based on the results of the recognition procedure, the educational institution decides whether to continue the foreigner's education if the level of his/her entrance qualification is recognized as acceptable, otherwise the foreigner will be expelled.

If the submitted document on the educational level is not confirmed, the educational institution expels such a foreigner.
